## A Level Graphics

We would like you to investigate the theme of Architecture in preparation for the course. This is a theme that many designers have studied and can be interpreted in many ways.

Firstly, take a minimum of 10 different photographs based around the theme Architecture. This is a good chance to get out and about and photograph your surroundings. Look for interesting architecture you haven't noticed before or perhaps look at things in a different way. You can photograph any buildings and architecture.

Use your design skills to take creative shots, considering angles, perspective and lighting. This work will be a starting point for your first project in September.

You will use these photos to develop your Graphics skills. Bring in a digital format. Below are some designers that use architecture in their work. Have a look at their work and then choose one to inspire your own piece.

Create a piece of work inspired by the designer, and using your own photos. Consider the composition and colour scheme.

You can create these on Photoshop if you have it, or on a good online version called Photopea. The main thing is to show your understanding of the artist through a quality piece.
