We wish them all the best with their applications. We highly encourage all students to complete their UCAS applications as soon as possible. Mrs Pedley sent out a Parent Mail last week to inform you about the payment process of UCAS. Please continue to support your son/daughter with the completion of their UCAS application forms. Year 13 students will be issued with their first Progress Report of this academic year on 19th October. I hope that when students receive these they will reflect on what this information means to them. Furthermore providing them with a benchmark of where they are in regards to their UCAS application forms. Lateral Flow Testing has proven an essential part of our safety plan, with the vast majority of cases in school being detected via home LFT of asymptomatic children, meaning those positive cases are kept out of school, keeping us all safe. I would once again urge all of our community to test regularly, ideally on a Sunday evening/Monday morning and again on a Wednesday evening/Thursday morning with all results reported via [Test Register - to record LFT results](#)

The government has recently stated that home testing will continue and we will therefore distribute additional LFT kits and we would urge you to ask your child to bring these home and continue or resume testing regularly.

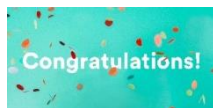
Alumni Event for National Poetry Day

The University of Birmingham recently launched EPS Futures, a **fully funded foundation year providing mixed Science and Maths curriculum allowing progression to a range of subsequent three or four year Engineering and Physical Science degrees**. The year is fully funded covering both tuition fees and accommodation costs and entry requirements are much lower than our usual courses, around CCC grades.
