Due to fixture clashes game counts twice as the home and away fixture so a brilliant afternoon all round.

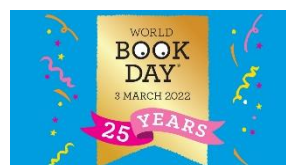
The new kit was a huge success as well!

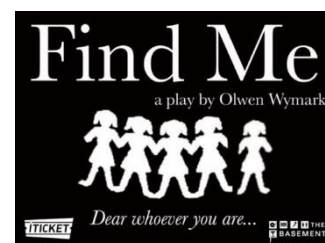

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## Student webinar - Sharing Science: Chasing chimps, digging dinosaurs and asking Attenborough Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 15.35 - 16.35

Why do so many people feel scared of science? When is it okay to let small children handle eyeballs when eating muffins? How can we channel our 'Inner Attenborough'?



Ben Garrod is Professor of Evolutionary Biology and Science Engagement at UEA. After living across Africa and Asia and working alongside wild chimpanzees and orangutans, he completed a PhD and got ready for a career of research, but instead followed a passion to share science with as many people as possible. In this talk, Ben shares his adventures about excavating mammoths, being chatted up by a robot, and why there's a whole career in sharing science with others.
