We continue to wish our Year 13 students good luck with their final examinations.

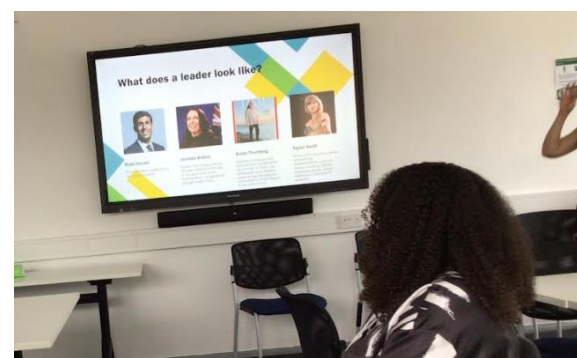
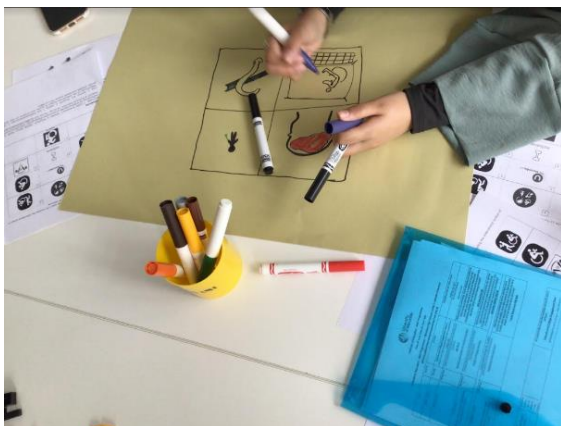
