### Not allowed!



- Bright hair colour
- Excessive piercings



- Blouse/top with appropriate sleeve and neckline
- Smart skirt of a suitable length/full length trousers
- Cardigan/jumper/smart jacket



- Collared shirt
- Trousers (of neutral colour)
- Shoes
- Tie
- Optional suit jacket and/or V-neck jumper



## What not to wear!



- Hoodies
- Denim
- T-shirts/vest tops
- Shorts
- Clothing that is too revealing or likely to cause embarrassment
- Logos/brands/images
- Leggings
- Canvas shoes/trainers and flip flops
- Leather
